Amethyst Class will be visiting Copsgrove Farm in Bisley.

We will be going whatever the weather so your child will need to have full waterproofs (including trousers and wellies). If you have any problems getting these items please speak with Mrs. Golding. If the weather is dry your child will still need to wear long trousers and sensible footwear / wellies as they will be walking through meadows. A hat and sun cream will be necessary too if the day is sunny. If your child has a hay fever allergy please ensure they take medication on the day of the visit.

Everyone will need to bring a packed lunch in a **backpack** - this is essential as they will be walking from the village to the farm - with plenty to drink (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). If your child is eligible for income related free school meals and requires a packed lunch from the school kitchen please indicate on the slip below. **Orders for these must be received by Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> July at the latest** so that the cook can order her supplies.

The PTFA have very generously agreed to pay for the cost of the coach to Bisley and as a result the only cost is £5.50 towards the charge for the educational facilities which are led by a qualified teacher at the farm.

We are really looking forward to this trip as a lovely way to mark the end of our year together.
