Ideas for Home Learning

- Please continue to share your child's school reading book regularly - we aim to share a book 1:1 twice per week - we will not give a new book until your child has had an opportunity to consolidate their reading at home
- Phase 2 and 3 Tricky Words are sent home on a bookmark attached to your child's reading diary - please practise lots!
- Please continue to support phonics home learning by supporting your child to carry out the writing/game associated with the sounds & tricky words covered that week at school
- Playing board games and informal counting along with spotting and discussing number when out and about on signs in shop, number plates/road signs etc really helps to put number into context
- Share a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts with your child at bedtime is a great way to extend your child's vocabulary, reading skills and understanding of how books "work"
- Visit Stroud Library regularly to complement our class visit to choose and change books
- Send in your child's favourite story/book for us to share with the class
