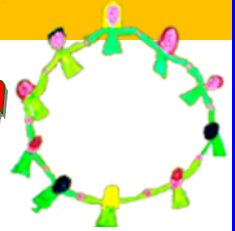


# Stroud Valley Community School Newsletter

Snapchat - 13 years of age

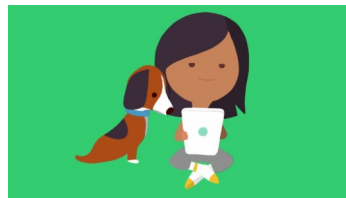
