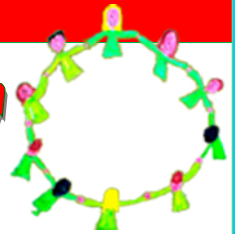


# Stroud Valley Community School Newsletter
