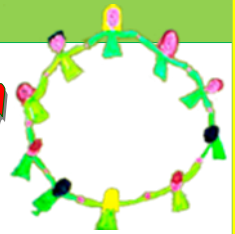
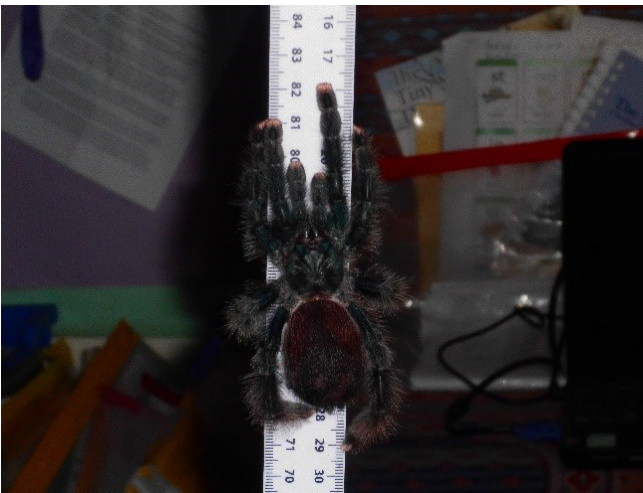

GOVERNING BODY UPDATE

The Full Governing Body had a busy and interesting meeting this week. The new GDPR

requirements will affect the school and Miss Sleep assured us that she has attended training and that the school complies with

all our data responsibilities. A new data protection policy has been written and this was signed off at this meeting. The

Governing Body were also interested to hear how SATs and Phonics test are administered and the stringent conditions imposed to ensure security of results. The Chair of Governors attended school to provide an independent overseer to the process last week.

Governors have been made aware that increasing numbers of children are being collected late and complaints have been

received about how this is dealt with. Therefore a new "Before and After School Responsibility" policy to clarify the situation has been unanimously agreed, ratified and put on to the website. Finally

Miss Sleep explained about the new ParentMail app which has been introduced. This should make communications more convenient for parents and document traceability more effective for the school.
