Guided reading

Children will use their skills of 'tune in, tune out' to develop their confidence at reading out loud to an audience. We will be focusing on questioning and inference skills.

We will be reading 'The Lost Happy Endings'.

Maths

We will be focusing place value of three and four digit numbers. Children will recognise the value of each digit. We will be rounding to the nearest 10 and 100 as well as comparing and ordering numbers.

Add and subtract two and three digit numbers using mental and written methods.

Times tables. Use knowledge of times tables to solve multiplication and division problems.
