Geography

We will learn to:

Develop Ideas

Investigate places

This concept involves understanding the geographical location of places and their physical features

- Identify the key features of a location in order to say whether it is a city, town, village, coastal or rural area.
- Use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of the school and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.

Investigate patterns

This concept involves understanding the relationships between the physical features of places and the human activity within them.

- Understand geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of a small area of the United Kingdom
- Identify land use around the school.

Communicate geographically

This concept involves understanding geographical representations, vocabulary and techniques.

Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to:

- key human features, including: city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office and shop.
- Devise a simple map; and use and construct basic symbols in a key.

Biology

Understand plants

This concept involves becoming familiar with different types of plants, their structure and reproduction.

- Identify and name a variety of common plants, including garden plants, wild plants and trees and those classified as deciduous and evergreen.
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers.

Understand animals and humans

This concept involves becoming familiar with different types of animals, humans and the life processes they share.

- Identify name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.
- Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.

Understand the Earth's movement in space. This concept involves understanding what causes seasonal changes, day and night.

- Observe changes across the four seasons (on going all year)
