Trip to Capel's Mill

Ruby and Diamond Class continued their topic of 'canals' and visited Capel's Mill this week. We learnt more about what buildings and structures had been built around the canal and why, dating back to the late 1800s. We learnt that where the new canal had been dug, it was once a rubbish dump. So the children became archaeologists and 'discovered' lots of objects that had been unearthed when the canal was built: old shoes, crockery, bottles etc. The children then talked about what stories the objects might have. We looked at old maps and photographs of the viaduct, as well as a painting of Capel's Mill (now you can just see some of the foundations next to the river.) We are so lucky to have this fascinating history on our doorstep, as well as
