### ATTENDANCE UPDATE

So far this academic year, Stroud Valley attendance has totalled **92.8%** this compares to the current 2024/2025 national attendance of 93.5%.

A reminder that children need to be on site at school between 8.40am-8.50am.

Having looked at the registers, lateness is a an issue for us. If your child is 5 minutes late every day they will miss 3 days of learning each year.

If your child is 15 minutes late every day they will miss 2 weeks of learning each year.

Arriving late can be very disruptive for your child, the teacher, and the other children in the class.

#### IT ALL ADDS UP!

#### Attending school everyday gives your child the best chance of success 100%

Attending 4.5 days a week = 4 weeks learning missed per year 90%

Attending 4 days a week = 8 weeks learning missed per year 80%

Attending 3.5 days a week = 12 weeks learning missed per year 70%

80% attendance adds up to missing 2 full years of education over their school life!

Being late for school reduces learning time.

5 minutes late every day = 3 days of learning missed per year

15 minutes late everyday = 9 days of learning missed per year
